

Health and Safety Guidelines



Enhanced Cleaning

The Clayton Center has implemented enhanced cleaning protocols for all its spaces, including the auditorium. All of our cleaning and sanitization practices were developed in accordance with CDC, North Carolina and Town of Clayton guidelines.



Masks Required

The use of face masks is required at The Clayton Center. We ask that all patrons wear a face mask throughout the performance. Patrons will be notified immediately of any changes or updates to this policy.



Feeling Sick?

Patrons who feel ill are asked to stay home. The Clayton Center has modified its refund/exchange policy for 2021-2022, and patrons who are unable to attend due to illness should contact the box office prior to the event to discuss their options.



Flexible Seating

Tickets will be sold as reserved seating with no spacing between seats. However, a distanced seating option will be available for patrons who decide to move their seats when they arrive (subject to availability).
